



Eligibilities

Students, including students who are successful in DSA-Sec, will be informed of their eligibilities via the S1 Portal and through their personalised Eligibility Letter. The eligibilities are as follows:

- Posting Group option
- Third Languages
- Posting advantage for admission to Special Assistance Plan schools
- Higher Mother Tongue Language (HMTL)
- Affiliation Priority
- Edusave Scholarships for Independent Schools
- UPLIFT Scholarship

Eligibilities – Posting Group (PG) Option

Eligibility Criteria:

Posting Group	PSLE score	
PG3 or PG2 Option	21 – 22	
PG2 or PG1 Option	25	

- Students with PG option must choose one PG based on their learning pace and abilities before submitting their school choices. The chosen PG applies to <u>all</u> their secondary school choices.
- If no option is made, students will be automatically assigned the PG that offers subjects at the more academically demanding level.
- Students who are eligible for <u>only one Posting Group</u> will not be allowed to choose another PG.
- <u>Note:</u> Students who are successful in DSA-Sec should also opt for their preferred PG if they are eligible for PG option.

School Choice Submission

 All PSLE students who are eligible for secondary schools, are required to participate in S1 Posting, except for DSA successful students. Please see the table below on the types of PSLE students and their eligibilities.

School Choice Submission – Via S1 Portal

[NEW] The S1 Portal will replace the S1 Internet System from 2025. Parents/Legal Guardians will log in to the S1 Portal using Singpass to submit school choices and options.


Mode 1: Parents/Legal Guardians submit via the S1 Portal (From 11.30 am on first day till 4.30 pm on last day, Singapore time)

- [NEW] Submit via S1 Portal (https://go.gov.sg/submit-s1) using Singpass.
- No limit on the number of amendments throughout the school choice submission period.
- Applicants will receive SMS after submission/amendments.
- View submitted school choices/options even after school choice submission period has ended.
- Parents/legal guardians who have difficulties with the online submission may:
- Inform the other parent/legal guardian to log in to submit choices or
- Use FormSG available in the S1 Portal to seek assistance from the primary school or
- Contact child's primary school for help

School Choice Submission – SSP, CSS & SSS

Singapore Sports School (SSP)

- Students who accepted an offer from SSP <u>must</u> participate in the S1 posting process.
- Students will need to seek school transfer to SSP after the release of S1 Posting results.
- Students are NOT allowed to transfer to another school as they are required to honour their commitment to SSP.



- CSS and SSS admit students who are eligible for Posting Group 1. Students are strongly encouraged to
 visit and apply directly at CSS or SSS to better understand the subjects offered and the progression
 pathways. Students applying to CSS or SSS directly <u>must</u> still participate in the S1 posting process and
 indicate other school choices.
- Students will be informed of their application outcomes by CSS or SSS if they have applied directly.
 - For successful applicants to CSS or SSS, their S1 school choices will be voided.
 - For unsuccessful applicants to CSS or SSS, they will be posted based on their S1 school choices.
- For those who did not apply directly to CSS/SSS and wish to consider the school(s), they may also
 indicate CSS and/or SSS as their school choices during S1 posting process.

School Choice Submission: How to choose schools



- Take reference from secondary schools' PSLE score ranges in previous year
 - The PSLE score ranges in SchoolFinder serve only as a reference for students and parents to shortlist suitable secondary schools.
 - Actual schools' cut-off points (COPs) of the 2025 Primary 6 cohort are determined by actual school choices made
 by the students during S1 Posting Exercise and reflect the score of the last student(s) admitted into each school.
 The actual COP of a school is known, only after the conclusion of the 2025 S1 posting process.
 - Actual COPs can vary year on year depending on the cohort's PSLE results and their school choices in that year's S1 Posting Exercise. Note that the COP excludes the PSLE score of DSA students allocated to the school.
- Select schools carefully as the choice order will affect the student's school posting
- Do note that meeting the school's COP does not guarantee admission. If the student's PSLE score meets the previous
 year's COP of a school, it also means that majority of the students in that school have better PSLE score than him/her.
- To increase the chances of getting a place in the students' school of choice, parents are strongly encouraged to:
 - Use all 6 options with a range of COPs and rank their preferred secondary school higher in their submission.
 - Include at least 2-3 schools where the child's PSLE score is better than the school's previous year's COP.
- Parents are encouraged to discuss with their child and make careful decisions based on their child's strengths, interests, and other considerations, while also noting that posting is still based on merit, primarily determined by their child's PSLE score.

Other Important Points to Note

Specialised Independent Schools (SIS)

- NUS High School of Mathematics and Science (NUSHS)
- School of Science and Technology, Singapore (SST)
- School of the Arts, Singapore (SOTA)
- Admit students via DSA-Sec and do not take part in S1 Posting.
- May conduct Supplementary Intake Exercise (SIE) during S1 choice submission period if there are available vacancies.
- Interested students can refer to the schools' websites for more information.




New PSLE Scoring System
