SNACKS FOR BREAK TIME

The following examples are snacks for students that are easy to prepare and pack for consumption during class breaks.

WHOLEMEAL

- *Peanut Butter & Jam
- Cucumber and Tomato
- *Grilled Cheese

(wrapped in aluminium fail to retain freshness)

PIZZA

 Wholemeal bread pizza with vegetable toppings

(wrapped in aluminium foil to retain freshness)

VEGETABLES

- Carrot or cucumber sticks with chickpea dip (mashed chickpea with HCS orange juice)
- Boiled broccoli with cute toppers

FRUIT & NUTS

- Fresh fruit kebab
- Almonds added to plain cereal for a higher fibre snack or plain nuts











WHOLEMEAL WRAPS

- Homemade popiah filled with vegetables (toasted)
- Vietnamese rolls
- Slice into triangles and toasted to make "chips" (store in air-tight bag/ container to maintain crisp)



WHOLEMEAL PANCAKES, MUFFIN & CAKES

- Banana Pancakes
- Homemade with reduced sugar



POPCORN/ CRACKERS


- Homemade without additional toppings like salt, butter


Edusave Standing Order & MOE Giro Schemes

- All Singapore Citizens students will have an Edusave account automatically opened for them and receive a yearly contribution
- ✓ Parents can sign up for Edusave Standing Order to use the Edusave account to pay miscellanous fees and enrichment programmes to reduce out-of-pocket expenses
- ✓ We also strongly encourage that parents join the MOE Giro scheme, which allows:
 - Hassle-free payments for school charges (where Edusave funds cannot be used)
 - > Elimination of manual payments or the need for your child to carry excess cash to school
 - ➤ Facilitation of disbursements (e.g. school awards) or refunds (e.g. cancellation of programmes, excess payments)




- MOE captures Parent's/Legal Guardian's and Student's/Ward's information via the Student Details Form (SDF) Portal
